Set Agenda	To establish the precedence of topics up for debate	None	Majority
Opening Speakers List	Chair entertains motion to open the speakers list; speakers are added to the current speakers list by order of the chair	None	Majority
Setting Limit on Speaker's Time	Setting or changing speaker's time	None	Majority
Point of Information	To question the speaker	None	None
Moderated Caucus	To break from speakers list and let the delegates speak to each other; moderated by the chair	None	Majority
Unmoderated Caucus	To temporarily suspend formal debate	None	Majority
Motion to Amend Previous Motion's Time	Offers an alternative time to a fore-stated motion	None	Majority
Withdrawal of Motion	Withdraws current motion or resolution	None	None
Point of Order	To correct an error in procedure	None	None
Point of Parliamentary Procedure	To inquire about the rules	None	None
Consideration of Draft Resolution	Brings a resolution to the floor for debate; must have required signatories	None	Majority
Amend Draft Resolution	Brings an amendment to the floor for debate	None	Majority
Motion of Recess	To suspend debate and the session	None	Majority
Motion to Adjourn	Ends the session or debate	None	Majority
Table Debate	To postpone the debate for a period of time	1 pro & 1 con	Majority
Close Debate	To end debate and go to vote	2 pro & 2 con	2/3 Majority
Decision of No Action	Signifies no action to be taken in the matter and drops the topic from the agenda	2 pro & 2 con	Majority
Adopt by Consent	Pass a motion by unanimous consent	None	None
Roll-Call Vote	Vote by roll-call and not placards	None	None
